SHOWCASING PROJECTS: THE SPACE FOR SOLUTIONS

During its annual event in November, the PPF provides a "one-stop-shop" called the "Space for Solutions" where selected project leaders get to showcase and pitch their solution to participants, including to highlevel personalities, decision makers, experts and practitioners, the media, and potential partners and funders. The event offers a public platform for project teams to gain visibility and numerous networking opportunities.

BOOSTING PROJECTS: THE SCALE-UP PROGRAM

Each year since 2018, ten of the projects showcased at the annual Forum are selected to benefit from the Scale-up program (SCUP), an accelerator that mobilizes resources from the Forum's Secretariat and its network to help strengthen and grow these solutions and amplify their impact. The SCUP helps to better equip project teams for impact at scale through monthly calls with high-level mentors and peerlearning workshops.


